

## Guest Teacher

Guest Teachers will provide training on a specific topic for our Team Members during their Gathered Trainings. Gathered topics can range from practical life skills, theological issues, personal development, or a cultural issue. The teaching typically lasts 30-45 minutes with 15 minutes of Q&A at the end. ### Days & Times

- During Gathered on biweekly Fridays
- 11 a.m.-12 p.m. OR 1-2 p.m.
- Could do both sessions on a day, if requested/feasible

### Duration

- Could be just once
- Could be annually or biannually

### Demographics

- Adults
- Individual or small group

### Qualifications

- If teaching on a matter related to the Christian faith, you must be a Christian and your teaching must be in agreement with our statement of faith
- Need to have recognized authority by way of education, experience, etc.
- Be able to contextualize your teaching to our program
- Willing (if requested) to provide an outline or audio/video sample of your teaching
- Gifted, engaging teacher
- Comfortable teaching young adults (18 to 30)

### Responsibilities

- Teach at Gathered on practical life skills (car maintenance, financial budgeting, cooking and grocery shopping, professional development, etc.), theological issues (theology of the body, of work, of sex/gender, theodicy), personal development (spiritual disciplines, emotional health, vicarious trauma), or a cultural issues (racial/ethnic reconciliation, politics, gentrification) OR participate in a panel on a specific topic.
- Teach for 30-45 minutes with 15 minutes for Q&A at the end.
- Provide an outline and/or handouts for the teaching time.
