Days & Times

- Gathered: biweekly Fridays from 12:45 to 1 p.m.
- Opening orientations: 9 to 9:15 a.m. on Wed and Thu the weeks of Labor Day, Memorial Day, and New Years Day
- Gathered & Orientation: 2-3 songs

Duration

- Could be just once or regularly

Demographics

- Adult
- Individual or small group (under 5 people)

Qualifications

- Christian
- Experience planning worship services for an eclectic congregation
- Musician (either solo or can lead a group)
- Ability to plan their own arrangements and lead meaningful worship experiences
- Provide a sample recording (preferably video, can be audio) of you leading worship
- Reliable and punctual

Responsibilities

- Lead worship for Gathered and/or opening orientation
- Could be accompanied by a current Team Member
- Submit set list one week in advance, receive approval from staff (based on song familiarity and theme) and so staff can create lyrics sheet/slides
- Responsible only for songs, not liturgy; can collaborate with staff on liturgy if desired
- Bring your own instrument (BYOI)
- Prefer acoustic, but some A/V technology may be available depending on location
